



The project

Dual VET 4.0 is an Erasmus+ Capacity Building in Vocational Education and Training (VET) project aimed at modernising and strengthening dual VET systems in Tunisia and Morocco through the transfer and adaptation of European best practices. The project combines curriculum improvement, the enhancement of digital tools and the fostering of public-private cooperation to increase the relevance of learner's skills, improve employability and enhance the overall quality of VET. The project runs from December 2025 to November 2028.
